






ENHACEMENT WEB005 –DELETE MULITPLE TASK FROM TASK CALENDAR

Description: - To delete the task from task calendar we need to search the particular task along with date and then delete the task one at time manually. Suppose if “XYZ” task is scheduled 250 times and if admin wish to delete those tasks, he/she has to delete those tasks 250 times manually which is time consuming.

To delete multiple tasks from task calendar, we can have a checkbox next to each task instance. Once checkbox is checked, it will be marked for deletion. Also we need to have one more checkbox option on the top so that whenever we select that option all tasks instances on the current page gets selected and then we can delete it by clicking delete option. There should be confirmation message ‘Are you sure you want to delete?’ only once confirm, record should be deleted.

Scenario 1 - Delete single/multiple tasks on same page.

- After selecting single/multiple task, we can delete selected task by clicking delete option which appear on the top.
