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1.0 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Vista Processed Foods –Taloja – Mumbai –India Plant was supplying Veggie products to McDonald's India and McDonald's Middle East since 1998 until 2012. This plant was set up by OSI group in 1996 to supply McDonald's first store in India. It is an approved supplier to the McDonald's India and Middle East. This status represents a history of commitment in time and money to the McDonald's brand.

Considering growing volumes and limited capacities at Taloja, Vista presented a comprehensive long term Veggie value added business strategy, which was approved by McD. Vista has expanded the Veggie value added units at a leased location in South India (Madanapalle) in Jan 2012 and in North India (Sirhind) in Sep 2012.

Vista Foods manufacturing business did not have IQF Vegetable processing plant and back ward integration as no supply from within a vertically integrated frame work. However, the veggie manufacturing business expansion in 2012 has addressed this part to an extent. Vista's North facility is adjacent to the IQF veg supplier, who has been associated with Vista since 2001. This has further reduced the risk in terms of IQF veg sourcing.

Part of Vista OSI commitment as a supplier to McDonald's is to assure supply .Vista is committed to maintain uninterrupted Veggie products supply to McDonald's and has developed contingency plan for continuous supply. It has developed contingencies to keep McDonald's in supply no matter what is the emergency.






- Inaccurate forecasting or sudden extreme surge in usage
- Approved supplier's capacity constraints due to their own market needs
- Crop failure due to pest, diseases or climatic changes
- Breakdowns at the supplier's plant
- Strike labor / transportation / Floods / Earthquake /Fire etc.

All above risks may materialize and cause short supply of IQF vegetables for processing at Vista North Plant or Vista South Plant. Any of these events will result in short supply to Vista –Foods and depending on the duration, may deteriorate into out of stock situation at the DC and McDonald's restaurants.

With the commissioning of Vista North plant in Sep 2012, the IQF veg risk and been reduced to a greater extent as the IQF supplier (Pagro Foods) is adjacent to Vista plant. The IQF vegetables are not transported but just shifted from the cold store to the production area eliminating the transportation risk. IQF supplier being next to Vista plant can meet the emergency requirement of RMs at a short notice

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The contingency plan is to maintain various approved suppliers that can be used if there is a disruption of supply from the primary supply. Vista Foods today sources from four HACCP certified and approved suppliers and each supplier can ramp up some production to support Vista needs if the other supplier is unable to supply the allocated volume.

Vista Foods team updates and ensure all suppliers maintain proper certification and approval status.







- 3. Accident or fire at the packaging plant
- 4. Raw material shortage
- 5. Equipment failure at the packaging plant


Risk mitigation includes having multiple suppliers with capabilities to produce and supply similar quality of packaging. Vista ensures product quality compliance through regular supplier management meetings and consultations. The suppliers keep mandatory safety stock for key raw material to avoid the supply shortage problem.



Vista manages the inbound freight with the support of freight forwarders and clearing /haulage companies.


The outbound is handled McDonald's and outsourced to Food land carriers; they have their own contingency plan in place.
